
Glen Campbell

OTHER OVATION GUITARS

ACOUSTIC ROUNDBACKS

All are available in Natural finish, all but the Classic in Sunburst. All have the characteristic rounded bowl which, like an orchestra shell reflects sound more clearly and farther than does a flat surface, with instantaneous response.

STANDARD BALLADEER
Similar to the Deluxe model,
but without the custom
features.

THE CLASSIC
Melodically versatile;
intensifies the mellow sound
of nylon strings. 18 frets.

DELUXE BALLADEER

Custom styled with luxury detailing, a superbly hand-crafted instrument.

THE JOSH WHITE

A custom-styled, classic type with steel strings and slightly narrower neck. THE TWELVE-STRING

Similar to the Glen Campbell model, but without some "Glen Campbell" features.

ELECTRIC STORMS

All are available in Sunburst, Red or Green, Thunderhead also in Natural finish. Thunderhead and Tornado are available with or without vibrato. All have two pickups, and a neck easily adjusted without removing strings (an Ovation exclusive).

TORNADO

Extra pickup windings and special circuitry make it the loudest Electric Storm, ideal for hard rock, 6 strings. TYPHOON II

Bass. Tone control for each pickup can be set either "funky" for solos or deep and rich for background.

THUNDERHEAD

Custom-styled leader of the line. 6 strings. Unique functionalizing of controls gives more sounds with less switching. HURRICANE

Produces its unique 12-string sound with full tonal qualities that create an almost harpsichordian effect. TYPHOON III

Fretless bass. Positions where frets would be indicated by markers flush with fingerboard; helps become accustomed to the scale.
