

Because Lyrachord is stronger than wood, it needs no bracing. The braces that baffle some sounds in a conventional guitar are eliminated. The sound chamber is unobstructed, as it should be. Over the entire tonal range, you get the pure sound you want. And it is richer, fuller. A guitar sound with guts. For Lyrachord is both smoother and more sound reflectant than even the finest wood.

Just listen to an Ovation roundback. You never heard it so good.


Total volume from both pickups is governed by a master volume control. Each pickup has its own tone control. Without changing pickup tone, the proportional contribution of each pickup to total sound can be varied from 0 to 100% with a single blend selector. Thus, with exact settings of two control knobs, you can achieve sounds which would require trial and error manipulation of four controls on conventional guitars.

For out-of-phase, to increase treble and virtually cancel bass, simply set the blend control for equal pickup response and flip a toggle switch with your thumb or finger. (It has three positions; in-phase, out-of-phase, and "standby" which shuts everything off.)

You thus can create, easily and surely, virtually an infinite variety of sounds.

The 22-fret Thunderhead's normal sound quality is exceptionally clean and mellow. Extra pickup windings provide more output, while advanced electronic circuitry enhances tonal impact. This unique instrument is designed to provide the wide range of musical expression demanded by top professionals.



The Hurricane can be adjusted easily to the exact type of string action you prefer. Ovation design provides exceptionally easy and positive adjustment of neck angle, while a 6-way adjustable bridge enables you to adjust each individual string for intonation and spacing, as well as bridge height.

12-string tuning requires extra rigidity in the neck. To provide it, all quality 12-string guitars have an adjustable reinforcing rod, which also compensates for any warpage factor. In the Hurricane, unlike other 12-strings, this rod is easily adjusted without removing the strings.

Then, to facilitate your control of the 12-string's unique harmony and solo effects, the Hurricane has 23 frets instead of the more conventional 20 or 21.




For dramatic appearance, the peghead and body are stained to match, and contrast harmoniously with the Brazilian rosewood fingerboard.



With many amplifiers, loss of a special effect circuit can mean loss of all sound — usually in the middle of a number. Ovation "Amplicard" circuit boards are independent of one another. Should one fail, the others are not affected. You keep right on playing. And they are easy to replace. Each snaps in and out of place; there are no connections to make. It's done in a few minutes.






