## TROUBLE SHOOTING

## THE OVATION ACOUSTIC-ELECTRIC GUITAR

## Simple Method - Without the use of Test Equipment

1. Amp and Cord check

With amp on and cord plugged in, touch end of phone jack that goes into the guitar. This should result in a loud hum through the amplifier. If no hum is present, check amplifier or cord.

NOTE: Plug phone jack into guitar and turn volume up full (clockwise), and install new battery.

2. Output jack check.

Remove pre-amp from guitar - take cover off and touch center lead of volume control (with control up full - clockwise) with hand on probe or screwdriver. This should result in a hum through the amplifier. If there is no hum, remove and inspect output jack for poor connection.

3. Pick-up check.

Carefully lift pick-up out of bridge, pushing wire through from inside guitar. Check that both leads are connected and that they are not shorting out.

This method is generally enough to correct any problem that might occur with your Acoustic-Electric guitar.
